## IMPORTANT UPDATE for Summer Camp



You asked and we delivered! There was overwhelming interest in opening a session of Noah's SEALS the week of July 7-12, and so we are now accepting 5th—7th graders for that week. However, in order to do so, we had to move an allotted counseling pair from the Tadpole program for the same week. (There were currently no registrations for that program). Please know that both Tadpole sessions will remain open the week of June 23-28 so there is still an option for our youngest overnight guests!

Co-ed groups will need at least two adults - one male and one female. We recommend a ratio of one adult to every six youth.

The cost is \$52.00 per person. The final deadline to register is April 3rd (if space is available).

## Part-time Employment Opportunity

Are you interested in earning some extra spending money or paying off some debt? Perhaps you're a stay-at-home parent who would like a flexible, part-time position outside the home.

Overlook continues its search for additional food service staff. If you have kitchen experience and would like to make some extra money as a cook on the weekends, this opportunity is VERY FLEXIBLE! Since most shifts fall between Friday evening and Sunday afternoon, it would dovetail nicely with someone currently working in school food service. **Head cooks can expect to start at \$12 an hour while training with experienced staff. Once they can proficiently manage the kitchen and serving/dishwashing staff, they will move to \$13 an hour. (This is a newly advertised INCREASE) \*An extra \$1 an hour is given for all Sunday work.**

Those without experience can apply to work as an assistant cook and partner with our current cooking staff. (\$11 an hour). Organized, hard workers could easily pick up the necessary skills to begin cooking themselves!

Our 6 weeks of summer camp would offer the opportunity for many (or a few) week-day hours. Though it is a perk that many enjoy, this is not required of our year-round food service staff.

## Summer Mini-Camps For Adults


