## Serving Christ at Overlook

If you are a college age student or older you can invest this summer in a vital mission,  
an outreach of love and sharing that can change lives, including yours!

Consider serving in one of the following leadership responsibilities that define  
the staff and leadership community at Overlook this year.

### Counselor (22)

- personal sharing and modeling of Christian discipleship
- the enabler for a small group (5-7 boys or girls of about the same age)
- capable of working with ages 9-17, senior adults (2 days) and intellectually impaired adults (3 days)
- desire to grow in and share outdoor camping skills, outdoor cooking, hiking fire building, etc. (Pathfinder Counselor Only)
- coordinate with your co-counselor the small group experiences using camp curriculum





# Lifeguard (2)

- supervise lake for swimming safety
- maintain water quality in lake
- maintain attractive waterfront surroundings and grounds
- design waterfront programs and assist and support others in camp community programs
- mowing



# (1) Crafts Leader

- plan and implement crafts program for 3rd through 10th grades, intellectually impaired adults, and senior adults
- purchase much of the needed craft supplies for the season
- assist and support others in camp community programs

# Nature Leader (1)

- design and implement nature programs and activities for both small groups and total camp
- resource for counselors
- assist and support others in camp community programs



# (1) Pathfinder Director

- facilitate adventure program for Pathfinders- transportation, communication, supplies, training, and leadership. Includes canoe floats, trips, cookery, camp craft, etc.
- Requires special certifications
- assist and support others in camp community programs

The summer staff are in mission 7 weeks plus 12 days of training, which begins on Memorial Day and recesses the weekend prior to our first camp.

Because of the variety in program and the many volunteers working in the program, flexibility, enthusiasm, team spirit, and mutual support are important qualities. Though joys and rewards abound at Overlook, the Lord's call is basically challenging, responsible work, and living and responding with others in Christian love.
