Take a look at what it means to truly thirst for God in a “dry” world. Groups can spend a day at Mass Resort’s amazing water park facility! There is something for everyone!

Whiter Than Snow: *~WINTER ONLY~* ***Seeking to be made NEW (Psalm 51)***

This package will explore what it means for us to be made “whiter than snow” and how we can have new life in Christ. Groups can arrange their tubing experience at one of two conveniently located slopes: Bryce Resort OR Mass Resort.



Groups can choose to stay in the **Ritchie Retreat Facility (\$300 for the weekend)**, or the **Swank Memorial Retreat (\$35 per person for the weekend—minimum of 16 paying participants)**. The Ritchie Retreat can hold a maximum of 14 people. The Swank Retreat can hold up to 30 people. Group leaders will receive a 4-session devotion packet two weeks prior to the event date (providing that the deposit has been paid). Each devotion packet relates to the corresponding off-site adventure. Groups will also receive a meal planner & suggested event schedule. Bag lunches can be purchased from the camp for the off-site adventure for \$5 per person. Each group is responsible for transportation to/from camp AND the adventure site, the purchase of needed food and consumable supplies for meals/snacks (both retreat building DOES come with plates, cups, silverware, baking/cooking pans/pots), any consumable devotion material specific to your package, and the purchase of event tickets through the site of your choice.
